CRANE PROCEDURES & ETIQUETTE

BOAT OWNER CHECKLIST

- Notify Shores by email, loomis@shoresofleechlake.com, of your crane-in/crane-out date
- Notify Shores if you will need extra time for crane-in/crane-out, e.g. step mast, boat repairs, etc.
- Arrange for a proxy if you will not be present to lift your boat
- If crane-out, locate trailer/cradle prior to crane day and make any necessary adjustments or repairs: flat tires, pads, rotten boards, level cradle, etc.
- If crane-in/crane-out to cradle, and you want to participate in the Yardarm potluck**, bring a dish to share, help clean up the Yardarm after & remember to get your serving ware
- Arrive 30 minutes before the start of the scheduled lift
- Park east of the lodge. **NO PARKING BETWEEN THE GAS DOCK AND CRANE PAD!
DO NOT, EVEN TEMPORARILY; BLOCK THE SPUR
TURNAROUND AT THE SW CORNER OF THE HARBOR!**
- Remove backstay and attach a temporary backstay if necessary
- Attach guide ropes to your boat – 2 at the bow and 2 at the stern
- Know the location of and check all thru-hulls
- Be aware of your place in the crane-in/crane-out queue & be flexible if order is changed
- Pay crane “accountant” promptly!**
 - **Provide a blank check made out to the crane company OR**
 - **Have plenty of cash – “accountant” often not able to give change OR**
 - **Charge it to your Shores account – MUST TELL “ACCOUNTANT”**
- Scrub the bottom of your boat if desired. It is the individual owner’s responsibility.

**NOTE: REMEMBER THE 3 Bs
BE READY! BE SAFE! BE ON TIME!**

Safety Tips: Never walk under a “flying”/craned boat.

Be aware of your surroundings especially on docks.

Use good body mechanics; especially when hauling/placing straps.

When craning, do not be in a hurry; be safe, watch out for the safety of others and be organized.
